VD (5) 1 Baines' Sh Ch Bryerdale Quantas, presented a super outline, lovely balanced head, good length of neck leading into a well made front assembly, well ribbed back with deep chest, super rear angulation, he held a level topline which he kept at all times. He moved out with purpose. RBD & BVIS
2 Gregg's Locksheath Beach Comber, this boy was well balanced, with a good head, maybe a touch heavy in backskull, good angles fore & aft, he was a joy to watch on the move with an accurate footfall. Good coat.

3 Sandiford & Mazzeo's Hernwood Christmas Prince

PD (1) 1 Mitchell's Cottonstones Dawn Treader By Brobruick, happy 11 month old, lovely head, good neck well laid shoulders, good body & well angulated rear, he has a level topline & moved out well. BPIS

YD (3) 1 Mappin & Newton's Glenquin Hurricane Bryerdale, masculine, carrying an abundance of coat, head ok, good length of neck, he has good front angles, a deep chest & ribbing carried well back to a short loin, feet a little flatter than you would like, well angled rear, he carries himself well on the move, holding a level topline with good reach & drive in profile, a little close behind going away.

2 Hall's Rhiwgerrig Caractacus By Melview, liked this boys head, good neck & front, well ribbed back & has good rear angles, he holds a level topline & moved out well covering the ground.

3 Sandiford, Sandiford, Beagle & Beagle's Hernwood Master Blaster

GD (4,1) 1 Gregg's Caradilis Fiach Dubh, liked his overall balance, good head & neck, well made front, he held a good topline & had well angled rear. He moved out with style & held his outline.

2 Hall's Rhiwgerrig Caractacus By Melview

3 Sandiford, Sandiford, Beagle & Beagle's Hernwood Master Blaster

PGD (2) 1 Inglis's Caradilis Jumping Jack, liked his outline, head ok, he has a well laid front, deep chest & was well ribbed back, his rear angles are ok, he moved out well & covered the ground holding a level topline.

2 Bloxham's Caradilis Carog Dubh, this boy wasn't as mature as 1, quite a heavy looking head, a bit forward in shoulder placement, rear ok, he carried himself well on the move.

LD (5, 2) 1 Sandiford's Hernwood Rocket Man JW, super well presented dog, good head & neck, well placed front, he has a good return of upperarm, was well bodied with super rear angles & moved out effortlessly, good feet.

2 McCarthy's Hernwood Wizard Of Oz JW, liked the balance of this boy, he was a bit heavy in backskull for me & a bit throaty, but he has good angles fore & aft, he held a level topline & moved out well if a bit lethargic today.

3 Nagaty's Marlbeck Maldini

OD (3) 1 Sandiford's Sh Ch Hernwood The Botanist JW ShCEX OSW, I liked the balance of this boy, super head, well placed front with a good return of upperarm, good bone & feet, deep chest & was well ribbed back, with a short loin, long from hip to hock, with short hocks & good bend of stifle. He moved out effortlessly, & covered the ground, was true both ways. BD & BIS

2 Newton, Cornum & Timmermann's Am/Int Ch/Ch Carnoustie Let The Game Begin (AI) (Imp Aus) SGWC, stylish dog, good head & neck, well placed front, good body, well ribbed, for me he has too much rear angulation, has short hocks. Moved out well. Has plenty of coat.

3 Johnston's & Boxall's Ludstar Maccabee At Glenquin (Imp Ita)

VB (6) 1 Mappin's Sh Ch Bryerdale Qangeroo ShCEX (AI), lovely girl, super head & neck, well made front, good body, carrying plenty of coat, short loin, well angled rear & she moved out well & covered the ground.

2 Johnston's Sh Ch Glenquin Phoenix, I liked this girl, good head & neck, well made throughout, didn't always look her best stood, but she moved out so well & had style.

3 Hall's Melview Phoenix

YB (5) 1 Johnston's Glenquin Phantom, feminine head, she has good angles fore & aft, a well made body, good feet with correct pencilling, & moved out well with reach & drive, in good coat & condition.

2 Sandiford's Hernwood Superstition JW, this girl presented a lovely balanced outline, although not overly happy to be judged, I was able to handle her, on the move she carried herself well, just needs a touch more coat to finish the picture.

3 Jones' Rhiwgerrig Sonata

NB (3) 1 Jones' Rhiwgerrig Sonata 3rd in YB, like her head & neck, good front construction, rear ok & body, she looks very raw at the moment, but on the move she has has reach & drive & moves out with style.

2 Crowther's Ronaldsbill Mystical Fire, 5th in previous class, nice head & neck, ok fore & aft, well made body, her coat is coming in, moved well.

3 Potter's Benbuie Chinook At Coldwellfield

GB (5, 1) 1 Garbett's Gailiech Beverleydottir, this girl presented a balanced outline, ok in head, she had a well made front, with good angles, good length of neck, well angulated rear, long from hip to hock, she has a level topline, well made body which was well ribbed back, she was true on the move & covered the ground with reach & drive. Pencilling on toes & thumb prints above feet, tan was a good colour

2 O'Kelly & Hancock's Caradilis Eula Dubh, I loved this girl on the move especially when her handler talked to her & she pulled herself up to show a super outline & level topline. She was good to go over, but didn't always look her best stood.

3 Garbett's Langstrumpf Hochsommer

PGB (1) 1 Sandiford & Jarvis' Hernwood Lunar's Gin, well made girl, good head & neck. Good angles fore & aft, she has a deep chest & was well ribbed back, once she stopped pacing she covered the ground well & held her outline.

LB (6, 4) 1 Sandiford's Hernwood Eternal Flame, super make & shape, feminine head, good length of neck, well made front, good body & well angled rear, she has a level topline, coat was rather wavy. Moved out with an easy action. BB & RBIS

2 Hall's Clohass Diamond By Melview, different type, good head & neck well made fore & aft, she has a level topline, she had a handler to move her & initially didn't give her best, but she settled as she kept going.

OB (2, 1) 1 O'Kelly & Hancock's on the move this girl absolutely shines, & I thought she looked at her best free standing. She has a lovely head & expression, long neck, she has well laid shoulders with a good return of upperarm, moderately angled rear, good depth of chest & was well ribbed back. On the move she has reach & drive. Good markings & enough coat. RBB

Brace 1 Bloxham's
