BABY PUPPY DOG (5, 2 abs)

1. J Bloxham – Caridilis Carog Dubh, Masculine head with dark eye, good front, level top line, good rear angulation and happy and outgoing.
2. S Gregg – Caridilis Fiach Dubh, Litter brother to 1 and with all the same attributes I just felt his brother moved better on the day.

BABY PUPPY BITCH (5, 0 abs)

1. K Marsh – Kilnrae Back To The Future, Feminine head with clearly defined stop and depth of muzzle, good reach of neck, good forechest, well balanced overall and a level top line. Moved so well for such a youngster. Best Baby Puppy in Show.
2. W D Smith – Kewstoke Sea Queen Zena, Another pretty baby well balanced overall with good front, nicely balanced body and good rear angulation.

VETERAN DOG (7, 0 abs)

1. I & C Ford – Sh Ch Liric Fusilier With Shillary JW ShCM ShCEx, Handsome dog shown in super coat and condition. Head of good proportions with clearly defined stop and depth of muzzle, good reach of neck, well balanced, good depth and breadth of rib, good rear angulation and true on the move with a level topline. A very worthy RCC and Best Opposite Sex Veteran.
2. A & D Harker – Paradise Final Legacy, Like the substance of this exhibit with his masculine head and dark eye, good forechest, depth and breadth of rib, compact body and good rear angulation. Very nice on the move too.

Head of correct proportions with dark eye and clearly defined stop, good reach of neck, well balanced with good rear angulation. 2. N & H Taylor – Grayglacier Blue Marlin, A compact dog with attractive head, well coupled, good depth of rib and good rear angulation with a level topline which he kept on the move.

MID LIMIT DOG (3, 1 abs)

1. M Morgan - Caridilis Sky Rocket JW, Outgoing and confident in the ring this well balanced dog has a masculine head with dark eye, depth and breadth of rib and a level top line which he kept whilst moving around the ring with drive and purpose.

A Mappin – Sh Ch Bryerdale Texas Star JW, A feminine head and correct reach of neck leading into good forequarters, well balanced body, depth & width of rib, level topline, good rear angulation and width of thigh. Shown in great coat and condition and kept her level topline as she moved out with drive and purpose belying her age. A very worthy Best Special Vintage in Show.

2. J Dixon – Ecameadow Saffron With Wallbank, A very pretty compact bitch well balanced overall with good fore and rear quarters, depth of rib and good rear angulation. Moved so well on the day.

VETERAN BITCH (7, 1 abs)

1. A Phillips & T Watkins – Sh Ch Flaxheath Top Model at Glenmaurangi, A very pretty and stylish bitch shown in super coat and condition. Feminine head, good reach of neck leading into strong forequarters, well balanced body with depth and width of rib, level topline, good rear angulation and width of thigh. Super movement keeping her level topline whilst driving forwards and moving effortlessly around the ring. A very worthy CC, Best Veteran in Show and Reserve Best In Show.

2. Y Slaughter – Sh Ch Cairacailie Night Of Love With Ordett JW, A lovely compact bitch of all the right proportions. Appealing feminine head, good reach of neck, good forechest, well balanced overall, good depth of rib, level topline and good rear angulation. So pleasing to see another one moving out so well with drive and purpose.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (3, 0 abs)

1. D Green - Benbuie Shoshone At Malocomi, Pretty young bitch well balanced overall at a young age with good depth of rib, level topline and good rear angulation. Nice and true moving out too.

JUNIOR BITCH (3, 1 abs)

1. A Phillips and T Watkins – Flaxheath Cover Girl At Glenmaurangi, A lovely young bitch with pretty head, good reach of neck leading into very good forechest, great body with the right depth of rib, level topline and good rear angulation. Super on the move with poise and grace striding out confidently.

2. N & B Garbett – Gailech Beverlydottir, Good substance on this young bitch who is well balanced overall with both good forequarters, depth & width of rib, and good rear angulation. Moved out well with drive and purpose.

YEARLING BITCH (3, 0 abs)

1. Frost & Andrews – Lainnireach Born To Be A Star, A compact bitch with lovely feminine head, well balanced with good depth of rib, level topline, rear angulation and width of thigh. Kept her level topline while striding out confidently around the ring.

GRADUATE BITCH (3, 2 abs)

1. K Whiting – Locksheath April In Paris, A pretty feminine head and expression, good reach of neck, good forechest and very well balanced overall with good rear angulation and width of thigh. Kept her level topline on the move striding out confidently.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (7, 2 abs)

1. J Rand – Kintalis Winter Jasmine, This very pretty bitch has everything you would look for in a well constructed Gordon Setter. Shown is super condition her size and proportions add to her femininity. Nice reach of neck, good forechest, lovely body with level topline, depth and width of rib and rear quarters. Moved with real drive and purpose keeping her level topline and a serious contender on the day for a higher award.

2. O'Kelly & Hancock – Caradilis Sparks Will Fly JW, An elegant bitch with good stop, dark eye and good reach of neck. Good forechest, depth & width of rib, level topline which she kept whilst moving out well.

MID LIMIT BITCH (4, 0 abs)

1. F Boxall – Laurelhach Renaissance JW, Shown in excellent coat and condition with plenty of featherings adding to her overall stylish look. Pretty head with strong forechest and a nicely balanced body with good depth of rib, level topline and good rear angulation. Moved around the ring with ease.

2. J Osborn - Amscot Air of Success At Boyers, A pretty head with good stop, depth of muzzle and feminine expression. Well balanced overall with good depth of rib, level topline and rear angulation. Another with very true movement going around a large ring with ease.

LIMIT BITCH (6, 5 abs)

1. D Green – Benbuie True Colours At Malocomi, A pretty compact bitch with feminine expression, clearly defined stop, well balanced overall, good in forechest, depth of rib, good rear angulation and width of thigh. Very nice and true on the move.

OPEN BITCH (9, 2 abs, 1 withdrawn)

1. A Mappin Bryerdale Qangeroo (AI), Stood out from the crowd with her coat, condition and featherings but on going over her this is a very well constructed bitch indeed. Feminine head, good reach of neck, well balanced body with good forechest, depth and width of rib, good rear angulation and width of thigh. Moved out confidently with drive and purpose keeping her level topline. A very worthy RCC.

2. K Whiting – DT CH Locksheath Princess Tiana JW, A compact bitch with a pretty head, good stop and depth of muzzle with good reach of neck. Nicely balanced overall with good forechest, depth of rib and rear angulation. Moved out strongly keeping her level topline and easing around the ring.

3. I & C Ford – Liric Just Remember Me.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS BITCH (2, 1 abs)

1. J & N Speed – Ronaldsbill Magic Stars, A young pretty, compact bitch with good reach of neck, strong in forechest, depth of rib, well balanced overall with a level topline. Moved very nicely with drive and purpose. A very worthy Best Special Beginner in Show.
